Business records provided by an entertainment industry production company to the Office of the 13 Film Commissioner in order to receive sales and use tax 14 exemptions under sections 212.031, 212.06, and 212.08, Florida 15 Statutes, in accordance with section 288.1258, Florida 16 17 Statutes, are confidential and exempt from the disclosure provisions of section 24(a) of Article I of the State 18 19 Constitution and section 119.07(1), Florida Statutes. This 20 exemption is subject to the Open Government Sunset Review Act in accordance with section 119.15, Florida Statutes, and 21 22 expires on October 2, 2005, unless reviewed and reenacted by 23 the Legislature. Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public 24 necessity that business records provided by an entertainment 25 industry production company to the Office of the Film 26 27 Commissioner in order to receive sales and use tax exemptions 28 be held confidential in order to encourage the expansion of 29 the industry in the state through investment and job creation. 30 Furthermore, the Legislature finds that it would be an 31

invasion of privacy for these sensitive business records to be revealed to the public. Section 3. This act shall take effect on the effective date of SB \_\_\_\_\_ or similar legislation, relating to tax exemptions for entertainment industry production companies, б and shall not take effect if that legislation does not become a law. SENATE SUMMARY Provides an exemption from public records disclosure requirements for business records of an entertainment industry production company that seeks sales and use tax exemptions from the Office of the Film Commissioner. Provides a finding of public necessity and an expiration date.
