House Resolution

A resolution honoring the staff of WEDR 99 JAMZ's continuing dedication to the betterment of their community.

WHEREAS, since 1982, when WEDR led the community in calling for the release of several detained Haitian refugees, 99 JAMZ has provided African-Americans and community leaders in Miami with both a forum and a voice to express concerns that are important to them, and

WHEREAS, 99 JAMZ's never-ending commitment to the community it serves has helped to secure its place as the number one station in its Miami-Fort Lauderdale market and to become the first Black-formatted radio station in the United States to be sold for the phenomenal price of \$65 million, and

WHEREAS, under the leadership of Vice President and General Manager Jerry Rushin, WEDR has used its high stature and strong listener base to further its commitment to the betterment of its community, such as the establishment of the 99 JAMZ Jocks Reading Club, which encourages youth and adults alike to learn to read, and

WHEREAS, in its commitment to service, 99 JAMZ, through a partnership with the Miami-Dade firefighters, has succeeded in brightening the holidays in Miami by collecting over 3,000 toys which were distributed to both families screened by the Department of Children and Families and participants in the department's Foster Care Program, as well as to the Miami-Dade community at large at the 99 JAMZ Winter Wonderland, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Florida:

That the members of the House of Representatives pause in their deliberations to commend Jerry Rushin and the staff at WEDR 99 JAMZ for their ongoing efforts to serve and to better their community.
