A resolution designating the Town of Century as "Florida's Millennium City."

WHEREAS, Florida's northernmost city, and the northwestern gate to the Sunshine State, the Town of Century was founded in 1901 by the Alger-Sullivan Lumber Company after the company had established a sawmill in the area, and

House Resolution

WHEREAS, to celebrate and to usher in the new millennium, a two-day celebration was held, which featured an array of entertainment for all ages, culminating in a fireworks show at midnight on December 31, 1999, and the burying of a time capsule on January 1, 2000, not to be opened until the year 2025, and

WHEREAS, to further emphasize this unique period in its history, Century has won the approval of the United States Postal Service for the issuance of two pictorial postage cancellation stamps, each bearing the Century Millennium Celebration Committee's logo, designed by Deven Walther, a student from Jay, Florida, and the respective dates of December 31, 1999, and January 1, 2000, and

WHEREAS, the Century Millennium Celebration Committee has applied for the national designation of "Millennium Community," which would be conferred by a noncompetitive program of the same name designed to recognize the commitment of communities across the nation to bring citizens together around meaningful millennium projects consistent with the national theme, "Honor the Past - Imagine the Future," and

WHEREAS, it was most appropriate as the new century dawned to celebrate the achievements and growth of the Town of Century and its citizens, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Florida: That the House of Representatives pauses in its deliberations to recognize the Town of Century, Florida, and to designate the town as "Florida's Millennium City."
