Subsection (1) of section 466.004, Florida 10 Statutes, is amended to read: 466.004 Board of Dentistry .--11 12 (1) To carry out the provisions of this chapter, there is created within the department the Board of Dentistry 13 consisting of 11 members who shall be appointed by the 14 Governor and subject to confirmation by the Senate. Seven 15 members of the board must be licensed dentists actively 16 engaged in the clinical practice of dentistry in this state 17 whose principal source of income is derived from direct 18 patient care; two members must be licensed dental hygienists 19 20 actively engaged in the practice of dental hygiene in this 21 state; and the remaining two members must be laypersons who 22 are not, and have never been, dentists, dental hygienists, or 23 members of any closely related profession or occupation. One dentist Each member of the board must be a full-time faculty 24 25 member at a dental school in this state, and each other board member who is a licensed dentist must have been actively 26 27 engaged in the practice of dentistry primarily as a clinical 28 practitioner for at least 5 years immediately preceding the date of her or his appointment to the board and must remain 29 30 primarily in clinical practice during all subsequent periods 31 of appointment to the board. Any person who is connected in 1

any way with any dental college or community college may be appointed to the board so long as that connection does not result in a relationship wherein such college provides more than 5 percent of the person's income. At least one member of the board must be 60 years of age or older. Members shall be б appointed for 4-year terms. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000. SENATE SUMMARY Requires one member of the Board of Dentistry to be a full-time faculty member at a dental school in this state.
