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chapter 458 and chapter 459 by medical specialty and by 1 2 county; the dollar amount of uncompensated care for which the 3 hospital receives no reimbursement provided by Florida 4 hospitals licensed under chapter 395 by medical specialty and by county; the number of Medicaid physicians in the state by 5 6 medical specialty and county, and the average number of 7 encounters per physician. The results of the Medicaid provider survey shall be compared with the projected need for Medicaid 8 services by specialty and county, as determined by the 9 10 department.
