The President of the Senate shall 21 22 appoint the chair in even-numbered years and the vice chair in 23 odd-numbered years, and the Speaker of the House of 24 Representatives shall appoint the chair in odd-numbered years 25 and the vice chair in even-numbered years, from among the 26 committee membership. A vacancy shall be filled in the same 27 manner as the original appointment. 28 (2) The joint committee shall maintain a continuous 29 review of the Florida Statutes to identify obsolete and 30 inactive statutes and functions that government should no longer perform. The joint committee shall make recommendations 31 1

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to the Legislature, including proposed legislation, in an annual report to be submitted by October 15 of each year. Section 2.
