19	Section 3. <u>The Legislature finds that the disclosure</u>		
20	<u>of information identifying a person prescribing, preparing,</u>		
21	<u>compounding, dispensing, or administering a lethal injection</u>		
22	<u>for purposes of death sentence execution would jeopardize the</u>		
23	<u>person's safety and welfare by exposing that person to</u>		
24	<u>potential harassment, intimidation, and harm and would</u>		
25	<u>constitute an unwarranted invasion into the person's privacy.</u>		
26	<u>Therefore, the Legislature finds that it is a public necessity</u>		
27	<u>that this information be kept confidential and exempt from</u>		
28	<u>disclosure under public records laws.</u>		
29	Section 4. This act shall take effect on the same date		
30	that Senate Bill 6-A or similar legislation providing for		
31	execution of the death sentence by lethal injection takes
