Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 162, between lines 23 and 24,

insert:

Section 107. The sum of \$650,000 is appropriated to the Florida Commercial Space Financing Corporation from the General Revenue Fund for fiscal year 2001-2002, and the sum of \$650,000 is appropriated to the Spaceport Florida Authority from the General Revenue Fund for fiscal year 2001-2002. The funds distributed to the Florida Commercial Space Financing Corporation by the General Appropriations Act shall be used solely for funding aerospace infrastructure as defined in this sub-subparagraph. The funds distributed to the Spaceport Florida Authority shall be used solely for aerospace infrastructure funding purposes based on recommendations made to the authority by the director of the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development. Proposals for aerospace infrastructure funding through the authority shall be
