- 2. The Dade Amateur Golf Association shall receive the first \$80,000 in proceeds from the annual use fees for the operation of youth golf programs in Miami-Dade County.

 Thereafter, fifteen percent of the proceeds from the annual use fee shall be provided to the Dade Amateur Golf Association for the operation of youth golf programs in Miami-Dade County.
- 3. The remaining proceeds from the annual use fee shall be available for grants to non-profit organizations to operate youth golf programs and for the purpose of marketing the Florida Golf License Plates. All grant recipients, including the Dade Amateur Golf Association, shall be required to provide to the Florida Sports Foundation an annual program and financial report regarding the use of grant funds. Such reports shall be made available to the public.
- (c) The Florida Sports Foundation shall establish a Florida Youth Golf Program. The Florida Youth Golf Program shall assist organizations for the benefit of youth, introduce young people to golf, instruct young people in golf, teach the values of golf and stress life skills, fair play, courtesy,
