**Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 1, between lines 17 and 18,

insert:

Section 2. (1) The Department of Insurance is directed, in consultation with the Pollution Liability Council, to study the availability and cost of pollution liability insurance which covers sudden and accidental events.

(2) The Pollution Liability Council is hereby created and allocated \$50,000 from the Insurance Commissioner's Regulatory Trust Fund. The council shall consist of seven members, appointed as follows:

(a) Three members shall be named by the Insurance Commissioner, at least one of whom shall be from and represent the Florida Insurance Council and be a member in good standing of the American Academy of Actuaries and not an employee of the department.

(b) Two members shall be appointed by the Governor, at least one of whom shall be a representative of Florida
