A clause in a property or liability insurance contract that excludes coverage for damage caused by 11 12 the actual or threatened discharge or release of pollutants, including smoke, vapor, soot, fumes, acid, alkalis, chemicals, 13 waste, or any other solid, liquid, gaseous, or thermal 14 15 irritant or contaminant may exclude from coverage only incidents and hazards that are traditionally associated with 16 17 environmental pollution. Section 2.
