Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 2, line 13, delete that line

and insert:

Section 3. Section 2 of this act take effect only upon the effective date of legislation that makes any such information provided to the Department of Health confidential and exempt from section 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and section 24(a) of Article I of the State Constitution, until 10 days after probable cause is found that a violation of law occurred. Such legislation must also provide that information may only be used by the department or the Board of Pharmacy in a disciplinary proceeding brought against the pharmacist or by the department in any study of adverse incidents without identifying the patient, pharmacist, pharmacy, office, or entity by name, location, or other identifier.

Section 4. Except as otherwise provided in this act, this act shall take effect July 1, 2001.
