A bill to be entitled
An act relating to teenage driver education;
authorizing a board of county commissioners to
require by ordinance that an additional amount
be collected with each civil fine and used to
fund traffic education and awareness programs;
providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. A board of county commissioners may
require, by ordinance, that the clerk of the court collect an
additional \$3 with each civil penalty, which shall be used to
fund traffic education and awareness programs. The ordinance
shall provide for the board of county commissioners to
administer the funds or shall designate local safety groups to
receive and administer the funds.

Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2001.

SENATE SUMMARY

Authorizes the board of county commissioners to require
by ordinance that an additional \$3 be collected with each
civil penalty and used to fund traffic education and
awareness programs.
