If the cost of registration or housing fees charged the qualified beneficiary at the eligible out-of-state college or university is less than this calculated amount, the amount transferred shall not exceed the actual cost of registration or housing fees. Any remaining amount shall be transferred in subsequent semesters until the transfer value is depleted. A transfer authorized under this paragraph may not exceed the number of semester credit hours or semesters of dormitory residence contracted on behalf of a qualified beneficiary.

vocational certificate program conducted by a community college listed in s. 240.3031 or an area technical center operated by a district school board. The board shall transfer or cause to be transferred to the community college or area technical center designated by the qualified beneficiary an amount not to exceed the redemption value of the advance payment contract at within a state postsecondary institution. If the cost of the fees charged by the college or center, as authorized in s. 239.117, is less than the corresponding fees at a state postsecondary institution, the amount transferred may not exceed the actual cost of the fees. A transfer authorized under this paragraph may not exceed the number of semester credit hours contracted on behalf of a qualified beneficiary.

Notwithstanding any other provision in this section, an institution must be an "eligible educational institution"

under s. 529 of the Internal Revenue Code to be eligible for the transfer of advance payment contract benefits.

(13) REFUNDS.--

- (b) If the beneficiary is awarded a scholarship, the terms of which cover the benefits included in the advance payment contracts, moneys paid for the purchase of the advance payment contracts shall be <u>refunded returned</u> to the purchaser in semester installments coinciding with the matriculation by the beneficiary in <u>an amount which</u>, in total, does not exceed the redemption value of the advance payment contract at a state postsecondary institution amounts of either the original purchase price plus 5 percent compounded interest, or the current rates at state postsecondary institutions, whichever is less.
- (c) In the event of the death or total disability of the beneficiary, moneys paid for the purchase of advance payment contracts shall be <u>refunded</u> returned to the purchaser in an amount not to exceed the redemption value of the advance payment contract at a state postsecondary
