and insert in lieu thereof: herein promises to indemnify or hold harmless the other party to the agreement, contract, or guarantee for liability for damages to persons or property caused in whole or in part by any act, omission, or default of the promisee arising from the contract or its performance shall be void and unenforceable unless the contract contains a monetary limitation on the extent of the indemnification which shall be a part of the project specifications or bid documents, if any. Indemnification provisions in any such agreement, contract, or guarantee may not require that the promisor indemnify the promisee for damages to persons or property caused in whole or in part by any act, omission, or default of a party other than:

(a) The promisor;

(b) Any of the promisor's contractors, subcontractors,
