627.0915 Rate filings; workers' compensation, drug-free workplace, and safe employers.--The Department of Insurance shall approve rating plans for workers' compensation insurance that give specific identifiable consideration in the setting of rates to employers that either implement a drug-free workplace program pursuant to rules adopted by the Division of Workers' Compensation of the Department of Labor and Employment Security or implement a safety program pursuant to provisions of the rating plan approved by the Division of Safety pursuant to rules adopted by the Division of Safety of the Department of Labor and Employment Security or implement both a drug-free workplace program and a safety program. ~~The Division of Safety may by rule require that the client of a~~
