The intent of this provision is to allow school districts to tap the wealth of talent and expertise represented in Florida's citizens who may wish to teach part-time in a Florida public school by permitting school districts to issue adjunct certificates. Adjunct certificateholders should be used as a strategy to reduce the teacher shortage, thus, adjunct certificateholders should supplement a school's instructional staff, not supplant it. Each school principal shall assign an experienced peer mentor to assist the adjunct teaching certificateholder during the certificateholder's first year of teaching and an adjunct certificateholder may participate in a district's new teacher training program. District school boards shall provide the adjunct
