Pursuant to section 19(f)(2), Article III 8 of the State Constitution, the Comprehensive Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services Trust Fund shall, unless 10 terminated sooner, be terminated on July 1, 2005. Prior to its 11 scheduled termination, the trust fund shall be reviewed as 12 provided in section 215.3206(1) and (2), Florida Statutes. 13 Section 3.
