Citrus Canker Compensation Trust Fund 13 14 created; limited purposes. --There is created the Citrus Canker Compensation 15 (1) 16 Trust Fund within the Department of Agriculture and Consumer 17 Services. The proceeds of the excise tax on standard packed boxes of citrus fruit shall be credited to the trust fund, as 18 19 well as any moneys specifically transferred or appropriated 20 for transfer to the fund in the General Appropriations Act. 21 The Citrus Canker Compensation Trust Fund shall be (2) 22 administered by the Department of Agriculture and Consumer 23 Services and shall be used for the purposes of paying compensation to claimants for citrus trees destroyed pursuant 24 25 to the state's eradication of citrus canker, for administering the compensation program, or as otherwise provided for in the 26 27 General Appropriations Act. 28 (3) Notwithstanding section 216.301, Florida Statutes, and pursuant to section 216.351, Florida Statutes, any balance 29 30 in the trust fund at the end of any fiscal year shall remain 31

in the trust fund at the end of the year and shall be available for carrying out the purposes of the trust fund. (4) Pursuant to Section 19(f)(2), Article III of the State Constitution, the trust fund shall, unless terminated sooner, be terminated on July 1, 2005. However, before its б scheduled termination, the trust fund shall be reviewed as provided in section 215.3206(1) and (2), Florida Statutes. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, but it shall not take effect unless it is enacted by at least a three-fifths vote of the membership of each house of the Legislature.
