Citrus Canker Compensation Trust Fund 14 created; limited purposes .--15 There is created the Citrus Canker Compensation (1)Trust Fund within the Department of Agriculture and Consumer 16 17 Services. Funds to be credited to the trust fund shall consist 18 of moneys specifically transferred or appropriated for 19 transfer to the trust fund in the General Appropriations Act. 20 The Citrus Canker Compensation Trust Fund shall be (2) administered by the Department of Agriculture and Consumer 21 22 Services and shall be used for the purposes of paying 23 compensation to claimants for citrus trees destroyed on residential property pursuant to the state's eradication of 24 citrus canker, for administering the compensation program, or 25 as otherwise provided for in the General Appropriations Act. 26 27 (3) Notwithstanding section 216.301, Florida Statutes, and pursuant to section 216.351, Florida Statutes, any balance 28 29 in the trust fund at the end of any fiscal year shall remain in the trust fund at the end of the year and shall be 30 available for carrying out the purposes of the trust fund. 31

(4) Pursuant to Section 19(f)(2), Article III of the State Constitution, the trust fund shall, unless terminated sooner, be terminated on July 1, 2005. However, before its scheduled termination, the trust fund shall be reviewed as provided in section 215.3206(1) and (2), Florida Statutes. Section 2. This act shall take effect on the date that Senate Bill 170, relating to citrus canker compensation, or similar legislation takes effect, but it shall not take effect unless it is enacted by at least a three-fifths vote of the membership of each house of the Legislature. STATEMENT OF SUBSTANTIAL CHANGES CONTAINED IN COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR Senate Bill 1244 Committee Substitute for Senate Bill 1244 is different from Senate Bill 1244 in that it: --Specifies that funds credited to the Citrus Canker Compensation Trust Fund shall consist of moneys specifically transferred or appropriated for transfer in the General Appropriations Act. --Clarifies that compensation will be paid to claimants for citrus trees destroyed on residential property. --Provides that the act shall take effect on the date Senate Bill 170, relating to citrus canker compensation, or similar legislation takes effects.
