A bill to be entitled
An act relating to contracting; amending s.
489.537, F.S.; providing that any county or
municipality may require the presence of an
electrical journeyman on each job site at which
electrical work is being performed; providing
an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (f) is added to subsection (3) of
section 489.537, Florida Statutes, to read:

489.537 Application of this part.--

(3) Nothing in this act limits the power of a
municipality or county:

(f) To require that a licensed electrical journeyman
be present on each job site when electrical work is being
performed in order to supervise or perform such work.

Additionally, the county or municipality may require that a
licensed electrical journeyman be present on any job site.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001.

LEGISLATIVE SUMMARY

Provides that any county or municipality may require the
presence of an electrical journeyman on each job site at
which electrical work is being performed. (See bill for
