## I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Lifetime Fish and Wildlife Trust Fund, Flair #77-2-458, without modification, effective November 4, 2004. The Lifetime Fish and Wildlife Trust Fund is administered by the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission. This fund was last re-created effective November 4, 2000, by Chapter 97-131, Laws of Florida.

Section 372.105, F.S., creates the fund, provides purpose and revenue sources.

The Lifetime Fish and Wildlife Trust Fund provides funding for fish and wildlife conservation programs throughout the state.

#### 3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The primary source of revenues for the Lifetime Fish and Wildlife Trust Fund is proceeds from the sale of lifetime sportsman, hunting and fishing licenses

B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.
