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Senator Sanderson moved the following amendment:

**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 3, between lines 17 and 18,

insert:

Section 3. The Department of Health and the Agency for Health Care Administration shall monitor the total Medicaid expenditures for services made under this act. If Medicaid expenditures are projected to exceed the amount appropriated by the Legislature, the Department of Health shall limit the number of screenings to ensure Medicaid expenditures do not exceed the amount appropriated. The Department of Health, in cooperation with the Agency for Health Care Administration, shall prepare an annual report that must include the number of women screened; the percentage of positive and negative outcomes; the number of referrals to Medicaid and other providers for treatment services; the estimated number of women who are not screened or not served by Medicaid due to funding limitations, if any; the cost of Medicaid treatment services; and the estimated cost of treatment services for

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1 women who were not screened or referred for treatment due to  
2 funding limitations. The report shall be submitted to the  
3 President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of  
4 Representatives, and the Executive Office of the Governor by  
5 March 1 of each year.
