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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. Medication purchasing cooperative.--

(1) Notwithstanding any other general or special law to the contrary, the Agency for Health Care Administration, in consultation with the Department of Health, the Department of Elderly Affairs, and the Department of Management Services, shall establish a medication purchasing cooperative to assist

30 31 qualified individuals with the purchase of prescribed drugs at the best possible price.

- (2) The medication purchasing cooperative shall be administered by the agency.
- (3) The agency is authorized to promulgate administrative rules necessary to implement the provisions of this section.
- (4) Individuals eligible for membership in the medication purchasing cooperative include residents of the state who are 65 years of age or older, or vulnerable adults as defined in s. 415.102(26), Florida Statutes, and who have incomes at or below 250 percent of the federal poverty level. The cooperative shall develop and implement application and eligibility determination policies and procedures necessary to determine eligibility for and enroll individuals in the cooperative.
- cooperative shall solicit competitive bids from licensed pharmacies to obtain discounts on all prescribed medicines for cooperative members. Companies bidding to serve the cooperative's membership must bid a percentage discount on all prescribed medicines listed in the state's procurement document. The cooperative may solicit bids on a county, regional, or statewide basis. The agency shall select pharmacies to participate in the program based on price, extent of drugs discounted, geographic coverage, and other factors.
- (6) The agency may charge individuals enrolled in the cooperative a monthly membership fee at a level needed to fully offset the administrative costs of the cooperative. The agency shall issue an identification card to cooperative
