The formula for determining the number of 29 need-based scholarships at each school is: for a school that 30 has an enrollment of more than 10,000, multiply the total enrollment of full-time students during the previous semester 31

by 2 percent; and, for a school that has an enrollment of 10,000 or less, multiply the total enrollment of full-time students during the previous semester by 3 percent. The qualifications required of these students are the same as those for community-college students who receive need-based scholarships. A student must qualify and be accepted by a university in order to receive the funds. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001.

SENATE SUMMARY Requires the state to set aside money to fund need-based scholarships at 4-year state universities. Provides formulae for determining the number of need-based scholarships to be funded at each school. Prescribes qualifications of students who may receive need-based scholarships.
