(1) The School District Capital Outlay Trust Fund is
created within the Department of Education. The trust fund
shall be comprised of moneys deposited pursuant to s.
199.292(2) and otherwise appropriated by the Legislature for
school district capital outlay purposes, including school

s. 236.25(2) and (5). The trust fund is exempt from the
