A bill to be entitled
An act relating to continuing dental education;
amending s. 456.031, F.S.; providing an
alternative by which licensees may comply with
a general requirement that they take domestic
violence education courses; providing an
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (3) of section 456.031, Florida
Statutes, is amended to read:

456.031 Requirement for instruction on domestic
violence.--

(3)

(a) In lieu of completing a course as required in
subsection (1), a licensee or certificateholder may complete a
course in end-of-life care and palliative health care, if the
licensee or certificateholder has completed an approved
domestic violence course in the immediately preceding
biennium.

(b) In lieu of completing a course as required by
subsection (1), a person licensed under chapter 466, who has
completed an approved domestic violence education course in
the immediately preceding 2 years may complete a course
approved by the Board of Dentistry.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001.

SENATE SUMMARY

Provides an alternative for certain required continuing
dental education domestic violence course requirements.
