(5)(a) Any student for whom the state is paying a foster care board payment pursuant to s. 409.145(3) or parts II and III of chapter 39, for whom the permanency planning goal pursuant to ~~part III~~ of chapter 39 is long-term foster care or independent living, who is or was at the time he or she turned 18 years old in the custody of a relative under s.

1 the student shall have applied for and been denied financial
2 aid, pursuant to s. 240.404, which would have provided, at a
3 minimum, payment of all undergraduate fees. Such exemption

5 relative under s. 39.5085 at the time he or she turned 18
6 years old or was adopted from the Department of Children and
7 Family Services after May 5, 1997; however, the exemption
8 shall be valid for no more than 4 years after the date of
9 graduation from high school.
