An act relating to greyhound adoptions; requiring dogracing permitholders to provide a greyhound adoption booth at each dogracing facility in the state; requiring that information concerning the adoption of a greyhound be made available to the public at the facility; requiring the permitholder to provide adoption information in racing programs and identify greyhounds that will become available for adoption; authorizing the permitholder to hold an additional charity day that is designated as "Greyhound Adopt-A-Pet Day"; requiring that profits derived from the charity day be used to fund activities promoting the adoption of greyhounds; providing an effective date.

Section 1. Greyhound adoptions. --

(1) Each dogracing permitholder operating a dogracing facility in this state shall provide for a greyhound adoption booth to be located at the facility and operated during the hours the facility is open to the public. The greyhound adoption booth must be operated by personnel who are qualified to provide information to the public concerning the adoption of a greyhound. Information pamphlets and application forms shall be provided to the public upon request. In addition, the permitholder shall provide information concerning the adoption of a greyhound in each race program and shall post adoption

information at conspicuous locations throughout the dogracing 1 facility. Any greyhound that is participating in a race and 2 3 that will be available for future adoption must be noted in the race program. The permitholder shall allow greyhounds that 4 5 are available for adoption to be walked through the track facility and to be identified as available for adoption. 6 7 (2) In addition to the charity days authorized under 8 s. 550.0351, Florida Statutes, a greyhound permitholder may 9 fund the greyhound adoption program by holding a charity racing day designated as "Greyhound Adopt-A-Pet Day." All 10 11 profits derived from the operation of the charity day must be 12 used to fund activities at the racing facility which promote 13 the adoption of greyhounds. 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001. 15 16 17 SENATE SUMMARY Requires greyhound racing permitholders to provide information at each dogracing facility concerning the adoption of a greyhound.
