(3) All employees who are expected to, or whose 8 responsibilities require them to, have direct contact with 9 10 residents with Alzheimer's disease or a related disorder must, in addition to being provided the information required in 11 12 subsection (2), also have an initial training of at least 1 hour completed in the first 3 months after beginning 13 employment. This training must include, but is not limited to, 14 15 an overview of dementias and must provide basic skills in 16 communicating with persons with dementia. 17 (4) An individual who provides direct care to a person with Alzheimer's disease or a related disorder shall be 18 19 considered a direct caregiver and must complete the required initial training and an additional 3 hours of training within 20 21 9 months after beginning to work at the hospice. This training shall include, but is not limited to, managing problem 22 behaviors, promoting the resident's independence in activities 23 24 of daily living, and skills in working with families and 25 caregivers. The department must approve training offered in a 9 10 variety of formats, including, but not limited to, internet-based training, videos, teleconferencing, and 11 12 classroom instruction. The department shall keep a list of current providers who are approved to provide initial and 13 continuing training. The department shall adopt rules to 14 15 establish standards for the trainers and the training required 16 in this section. 17 (7) Upon completing any training listed in this section, the employee or direct caregiver shall be issued a 18 19 certificate that includes the name of the training provider, 20 the topic covered, and the date and signature of the training provider. The certificate is evidence of completion of 21 training in the identified topic, and the employee or direct 22 caregiver is not required to repeat training in that topic if 23 24 the employee or direct caregiver changes employment to or from a different hospice, home health agency, assisted living 25 26 facility, nursing home, adult day care center, or adult 27 family-care home.
