24	The CS authorizes the use of High Occupancy Vehicle lanes, regardless of vehicle occupancy, by Inherently Low-Emission Vehicle (ILEV) which are certified and labeled in accordance with federal regulations. The CS requires the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to issue a decal to be placed on authorized ILEVs.
