**Amendment to Amendment (913359) (with title amendment)**

On page 46, between lines 13 and 14 of the amendment

insert:

18 Section 25. The Legislature recognizes that the  
 19 Preservation 2000 program has provided incalculable benefits to  
 20 the citizens of Florida by funding the acquisition and  
 21 protection of more than one million acres of land for  
 22 conservation and recreation purposes. The Preservation 2000  
 23 Program has helped insure present and future generations  
 24 access to important open spaces and recreation and  
 25 conservation lands. It is therefore the intent of the  
 26 Legislature that any funds from the Preservation 2000 Trust  
 27 Fund redirected to Everglades restoration efforts by the 2001  
 28 Legislature due to current budgeting constraints be restored  
 29 by the General Appropriations Act for Fiscal Year 2002-2003 to  
 30 the Preservation 2000 Trust Fund. It is the further intent of  
 31 the Legislature that funds in the Preservation 2000 Trust

1 Fund, created pursuant to s. 375.045 and the Florida Forever  
2 Trust fund created pursuant to s. 259.1051 shall not be used  
3 except for the purposes for which the trust funds were  
4 created.

16 Trust Fund and the Florida Forever Trust Fund

18 which the trust funds were created;
