Resources Trust Fund shall be distributed by the commission between the Division of Freshwater Fisheries and the Division of Marine Fisheries in proportion to the numbers of resident fresh and saltwater anglers as determined by the most current data on license sales. Unless otherwise provided by federal law, the commission, at a minimum, shall provide the following:

8 (a) Not less than 5 percent or more than 10 percent of 9 the funds allocated to the commission shall be expended for an 10 aquatic resources education program; and

(b) Not less than 10 percent of the funds allocated to
the commission shall be expended for acquisition, development,
renovation, or improvement of boating facilities.

14 (3) All license fees collected pursuant to s. 370.0605 15 shall be transferred to the Marine Resources Conservation 16 Trust Fund within 7 days following the last business day of 17 the week in which the license fees were received by the 18 commission. One-fifth of the total proceeds derived from the 19 sale of 5-year licenses and replacement 5-year licenses, and 20 all interest derived therefrom, shall be available for 21 appropriation annually. 22
