c. No less than once every 3 years, the Public Service Commission or the county commission through the services of an independent auditor shall perform a financial audit of all facilities receiving compensation from an environmental protection disposal fee. The Public Service Commission or the county commission through the services of an independent auditor shall also perform an audit of the methodology used in establishing the environmental protection disposal fee. The Public Service Commission or the county commission shall, within 120 days of completion of an audit, file the audit report with the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives and shall provide copies to the commissions of the counties set forth in sub-subparagraph 5.b. The books and records, of any facilities receiving
