STATEMENT OF SUBSTANTIAL CHANGES CONTAINED IN COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR Senate Bill 1520 The Committee Substitute for Senate Bill 1520 removes from the bill requirements that the Department of Elderly Affairs and the Department of Children and Family Services develop expedited approval of providers of environmental modification services under the Assisted Living for the Elderly Medicaid waiver and the developmental services waiver, replacing this requirement with a requirement that Medicaid enroll any general, building, or residential contractor licensed under ch. 489, F.S., as a provider of environmental modification services for any Medicaid home and community-based services waiver; and defines "environmental modification services" and "environmental accessibility adaptations".
