United States armed forces form DD-214, 11 when filed with the clerk of the court, is confidential and 12 exempt from section 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and Section 13 24(a), Article I of the State Constitution. However, 14 information contained in that form may be released to a 15 personal representative, executor, or court-appointed guardian 16 17 of the person. This section is subject to the Open Government Sunset Review Act of 1995 in accordance with section 119.15, 18 19 Florida Statutes, and shall stand repealed on October 2, 2006, 20 unless reviewed and saved from repeal through reenactment by 21 the Legislature. 22 Section 2. The Legislature finds that exempting information contained in United States armed forces form 23 DD-214 is a public necessity. The information is of a personal 24 nature, and the potential harm resulting from its disclosure 25 26 is not offset by any possible public benefit. 27 Section 3.
