Section 1. Everglades restoration information outreach. -- The South Florida Water Management District shall, within existing resources, develop and implement an Everglades restoration information outreach program. The purpose of the program shall be to disseminate information and improve public understanding regarding the state's Everglades restoration effort, within the predominantly African-American and Hispanic communities located near the Everglades. The district shall, at a minimum, present information explaining the Everglades restoration process in newspapers and other media within the targeted communities and respond to the questions and concerns communicated by members of those communities. In addition, the district may make public presentations and, at the request of local school officials, present programs to children in the local schools, on the Everglades and the state's restoration process. The district shall seek the assistance and involvement of an African-American or Hispanic environmentalist or scientist with knowledge of the Everglades

to oversee the program and facilitate communication between the targeted minority communities, the district, and the Department of Environmental Protection. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law. HOUSE SUMMARY Directs the South Florida Water Management District to provide Everglades restoration information outreach targeting the minority communities located near the Everglades. Provides for dissemination of information, at a minimum, through newspapers and other media in the targeted communities. Directs the district to seek an African-American or Hispanic environmentalist or scientist to assist with the program.
