The organization shall 22 submit to the treating provider and the subscriber written 23 notification regarding the organization's adverse determination within 2 working days after the subscriber or 24 25 provider is notified of the adverse determination. The written notification must include the utilization review criteria or 26 27 benefits provisions used in the adverse determination, 28 identify the physician who rendered the adverse determination, and be signed by an authorized representative of the 29 30 organization or the physician who rendered the adverse 31 determination. notification of an adverse determination information concerning the appeal process for adverse determinations. Section 2.
