Senator Carlton moved the following amendment:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 18, between lines 28 and 29,

insert:

Section 9. (1) There is created an advisory committee on airport and seaport property taxation, consisting of 8 members, two of whom shall be appointed by the Governor. The President of the Senate shall appoint two members, one of which must be a member of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House shall appoint two members, one of which must be a member of the House of Representatives. The executive director of the Department of Revenue and one property appraiser appointed by the executive director shall also serve on the committee. The advisory committee shall study the taxation of airport and seaport property and shall submit a written report on this issue to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives on or before October 1, 2001. The committee shall receive \$100,000 from the General Revenue Fund for this purpose and shall expire upon completion of the
