10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

12 Section 1. Subsections (4) and (11) of section 865.09,
13 Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

14 865.09 Fictitious name registration.--

15 (4) CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP OR LOCATION.--

16 (a) If the ownership of a business registered under
17 this section changes, the owner of record with the division
18 shall file a cancellation and reregistration that meets the
19 requirements set forth in subsection (3) within 30 days after
20 the occurrence of such change.

21 (b) If the location of a business registered under
22 this section changes, the owner of record with the division
23 shall file a reregistration that meets the requirements set
24 forth in subsection (3) within 30 days after the occurrence of
25 such change.

26 (11) FORMS.--Registration, cancellation, and renewal
27 shall be made on forms prescribed by the Department of State,
28 which may include the uniform business report, pursuant to s.
29 606.06, as a means of satisfying the requirement of this
30 chapter part.

31 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001.
