A bill to be entitled
An act relating to police reports; amending s.
119.105, F.S.; requiring persons who request
access to police reports to sign an affidavit
as a condition of obtaining access to such
reports; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 119.105, Florida Statutes, is
amended to read:

119.105 Protection of victims of crimes or
accidents.--

(1) Police reports are public records except as
otherwise made exempt or confidential by general or special
law. Every person is allowed to examine nonexempt or
nonconfidential police reports. No person who inspects or
copies police reports for the purpose of obtaining the names
and addresses of the victims of crimes or accidents shall use
any information contained therein for any commercial
solicitation of the victims or relatives of the victims of the
reported crimes or accidents. Nothing herein shall prohibit
the publication of such information by any news media or the
use of such information for any other data collection or
analysis purposes.

(2) Every person who requests to inspect or copy a
police report must sign an affidavit as a condition of
obtaining access to such report.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001.
