Contracts for appraisals.--(1) The Department of Business and Professional 18 19 Regulation shall contract with qualified professionals for the 20 purpose of obtaining an update of the appraisal of the lands and facilities known as Hialeah Park and the pari-mutuel 21 22 permit held by Hialeah, Inc., utilizing the information filed in accordance with the provisions of s. 550.125 and the 23 24 existing appraisal submitted as part of the comprehensive 25 study of the feasibility of state or municipal ownership of 26 Hialeah Park pursuant to s. 12, chapter 98-190. 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appraiser from a list of appraisers maintained by the 1 2 Department of Environmental Protection, Division of State 3 Lands, Bureau of Appraisals. Upon completion of the 4 appraisal, such appraiser, and all subcontractors of the 5 appraiser shall provide written certification to the 6 department that the appraisal is in substantial compliance 7 with the Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice. (3) For the purpose of appraising the pari-mutuel 8 permit, the department shall select an appraiser from among 9 10 qualified persons who possess the requisite professional licenses and certifications to establish sufficient expertise 11 12 to perform the appraisal of the value of the pari-mutuel 13 permit. (4) Neither the appraiser of the land and facilities 14 15 nor the appraiser of the value of the pari-mutuel permit shall 16 have any ex parte communications with any party holding a 17 pari-mutuel permit until the conclusion of the appraisals, at 18 which time the appraisals shall become a public record and available for inspection by all parties. All such appraisals 19 shall be completed by November 15, 2001. 20 21 (5) In the conduct of the duties and responsibilities set out herein, the department and all employees, agents, and 22 others shall be subject to the provisions of chapter 119, 23 24 provided that the confidentiality of the appraisal and 25 communications with such appraiser shall be governed by subsection (4). 26 27 (6) A final report by the department containing the 28 information required under subsection (1) shall be filed with 29 the Speaker of the House, the President of the Senate, and the 30 Governor by January 15, 2002.
