Such guidelines must include requirements 20 21 for the assurance of quality and cost-efficiency of services, 2.2 minimum personnel standards, and employee benefits. 23 (b) The area agency on aging, in consultation with the 24 department, may exempt from the competitive bid process any 25 contract with a provider who meets or exceeds established 26 minimum standards, as determined by the department. 27 (c) In each community care service system the lead 28 agency must be given the authority and responsibility to 29 coordinate some or all of the services, either directly or 30 through subcontracts, for functionally impaired elderly persons.
