Paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 5 6 316.650, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 7 316.650 Traffic citations.--8 (1)(a) The department shall prepare, and supply to 9 every traffic enforcement agency in this state, an appropriate form traffic citation containing a notice to appear (which 10 shall be issued in prenumbered books with citations in 11 12 quintuplicate) and meeting the requirements of this chapter or 13 any laws of this state regulating traffic, which form shall be 14 consistent with the state traffic court rules and the 15 procedures established by the department. Upon all future printings of the traffic citation, the form shall include a 16 17 special box which is to be checked by the law enforcement officer when the officer believes that the traffic violation 18 19 or crash was due to aggressive careless driving as defined in 20 s. 316.1923. 21 Section 3.
