I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Grants and Donations Trust Fund, Flair #72-2-339, without modification, effective November 4, 2004. The Grants and Donations Trust Fund is administered by the Department of Management Services. This fund was last re-created effective November 4, 2000, by Chapter 97-136, Laws of Florida.

II. SUBSTANTIVE ANALYSIS:

2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The Grants and Donations Trust Fund provides funding for operations in various programs of the Department of Management Services.

There are several sources of revenues for the Grants and Donations Trust Fund, including fees collected by the Americans with Disabilities Act working group, revenues from PRIDE and from state agencies and vendors taking advantage of state term contracts, as well as federal grant monies.

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.

This legislation has no fiscal impact on state agencies or state funds, on local governments as a whole or on the private sector. It simply re-creates, without modification, an existing state trust fund and continues the current use of the fund.
