(c) School districts in communities with no food 28 29 recovery or hunger assistance programs are exempt from this 30 subsection. 31

(d) The State Board of Education shall have the authority to adopt rules pursuant to ss. 120.536(1) and 120.54 to implement the provisions of this subsection. Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
