Subsection (1) of section 440.101, Florida 10 Statutes, is amended to read: 440.101 Legislative intent; drug-free workplaces .--11 12 (1) It is the intent of the Legislature to promote drug-free workplaces in order that employers in the state be 13 afforded the opportunity to maximize their levels of 14 productivity, enhance their competitive positions in the 15 marketplace, and reach their desired levels of success without 16 17 experiencing the costs, delays, and tragedies associated with work-related accidents resulting from drug abuse by employees. 18 19 It is further the intent of the Legislature that drug abuse be 20 discouraged and that employees who choose to engage in drug abuse face the risk of unemployment and the forfeiture of 21 22 workers' compensation benefits. It is also the intent of the Legislature to promote drug-free workplaces in order to 23 provide safe working environments. 24 25 Section 2.
