(2) In accordance with Section 19(f)(2), Article III 18 19 of the State Constitution, the trust fund must, unless 20 terminated sooner, be terminated on July 1, 2005. Before its scheduled termination, the trust fund must be reviewed as 21 provided in section 215.3206(1) and (2), Florida Statutes. 22 23 Section 2.
