(1) The Services Trust Fund is created 15 within the Department of Management Services. Funds shall be 16 17 credited to the trust fund as provided by law and pursuant to legislative appropriations. The trust fund shall be used for 18 19 the purposes set forth by law. 20 (2) In accordance with Section 19(f)(2) of Article III 21 of the State Constitution, the Services Trust Fund shall, 22 unless terminated sooner, be terminated on July 1, 2005. Before its scheduled termination, the trust fund shall be 23 reviewed as provided in sections 215.3206(1) and (2), Florida 24 25 Statutes. 26 (3) If the trust fund is terminated and not 27 immediately re-created, all cash balances and income of the 28 trust fund shall be deposited into the General Revenue Fund. 29 The Department of Management Services shall pay any 30 outstanding debts or obligations of the trust fund as soon as

practicable, and the Comptroller shall close out and remove

the trust fund from the various state accounting systems, using generally accepted accounting practices concerning warrants outstanding, assets, and liabilities. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001, if SB ____ or similar legislation is adopted in the same legislative session, or an extension thereof, and becomes law. ********** SENATE SUMMARY Creates the Services Trust Fund within the Department of Management Services.
