If funds that are appropriated for families receiving priority 21 22 consideration for subsidized child care under this chapter or s. 411.10 remain unspent, such funds shall be used to provide 23 subsidies for families who are employed and whose income does 24 25 not exceed 200 percent of the federal poverty level. 26 Section 2.
